Semillon can be quite lean and restrained when youthful, and this is a classic example of that. This wine is unmistakably Hunter Valley, with hints of lemongrass, minerals and brown lime in the glass. Ever so light and delicate on the palate, yet containing surprising length and a lovely clean finish. This will repay careful cellaring for a very long time.
